

### MENTORING SUPPORT NETWORK (MSN)

MSN has served as a steady and secure ground for sisters as they have processed the transitions and vicissitudes of life.

Staying in God's wonder is having a mentoring relationship that gives you the freedom to choose, not for purely practical reasons, and affirms you for desiring to honor God above all else.

#### **REFRESH (June 20-22, 2014)**

Twenty of us began our descent into the silence on Friday night.



I entered the retreat a little apprehensive about having to share with and lead women in spiritual direction whom I had never met before. 


